

ANGAAD regulations

adopted by the General Assembly of the ANGAAD at Bamako on November 25, 2005

Article 1: Preamble. Contents and methods of algebra and geometry have evolved much recently thanks to the conceptual and software progress that make possible multiple applications, especially in the field of the protection of information, biology, optimization. Although marked in developed countries, this evolution is not always sufficiently observed in developing ones, especially in Africa, and more particularly in the English speaking part of African, where these themes are less developed. The ANGAAD aims at changing this situation. Its goals and objectives have been defined during its constitutive meeting of August 2003 at Trieste. Ruled by the present statute, the functioning of the ANGAAD relies on its scientific council, its general and national co-ordination and its council of co-ordinators.

Article 2: Scientific council. The scientific council is in charge of animation of the scientific life of the network, creation of encounters, writing up every two years of a scientific balance-sheet of the activities of the network, presented at the General assembly. It is consulted especially by electronic mail, for any question concerning the scientific policy of the network. On occasion of encounters or activities of the ANGAAD, members of the scientific council meet. The president of the scientific council is elected at a simple majority by members of the scientific council for a two-year mandate, renewable.

Article 3: National co-ordinators: National co-ordinators and assistant national co-ordinators are in charge of diffusion of the information, animation of the life of the ANGAAD, transmission of the balance-sheet of activities of the ANGAAD in their country, submission in due time of demands of support specifying priorities and objectives. The national co-ordinators and assistant national co-ordinators are elected by members of the network from their country for a two-year mandate, renewable.

Article 4: General co-ordinators. The general co-ordinators of the network are in charge of the general co-ordination of activities, specially identification and contacts of partners capable of sustaining the ANGAAD (ICTP (OEA), ICTP (Math group), CIMPA, SARIMA, IRD, TWAS, AUF, ISP, CEE, private foundations, ...), diffusion of information to the council of co-ordinators, (see Article 5), making the synthesis of demands of support transmitted by national co-ordinators, making arbitration and allotment proposals of the budget to the council of co-ordinators, in conformity with the objectives of the network, preparation of General Assemblies of the network which hold at least once every two years and presentation during these General Assemblies of moral and financial report. They are in charge of bringing out the adhesions of new teams or persons to the network. General co-ordinators of the network are elected by the General Assembly of the network, at a simple majority, for a two-year mandate, renewable, under the suggestion of the council of co-ordinators.

Article 5: Council of co-ordinators. It is composed of general co-ordinators, national co-ordinators or their representatives and the two members of the scientific council amidst which the president of the scientific council or its representative and a member elected within it. It is informed and consulted regularly by general co-ordinators by electronic mail and meet during the activities of the ANGAAD. It settles on the allotment of the budget, under the suggestion of the general co-ordinators.

Article 6: This statute can be modified only by the General Assembly of the network, under the suggestion of the council of co-ordinators.
